



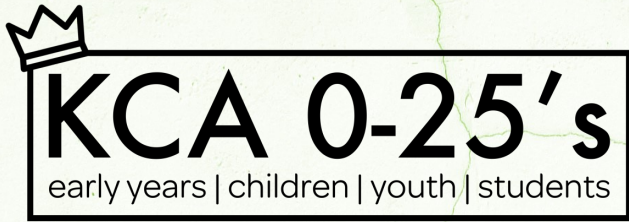

Theme : Creation Session Number: 1
Biblical Passages: Genesis 1 Topic: Creation

Passage Context

The opening chapter of Genesis talks about the creation of the world, that God is above all of creation and that humanity is made in God’s likeness. This opening chapter wasn’t written as a scientific explanation of how God made the world but that He is it’s creator. Genesis chapter 2 actually holds a second creation story if you want to explore the story slightly differently.

Key Teaching Points

1. God created the world & He made humans like Him
2. Humans were made to rule over the world!

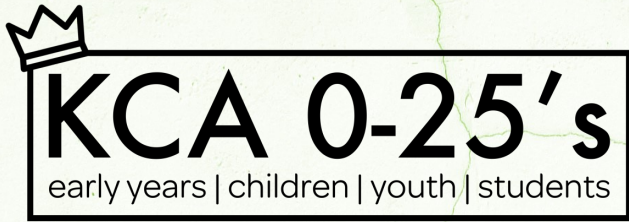

Give the youth an opportunity to say sorry to God for their sin and to be forgiven.

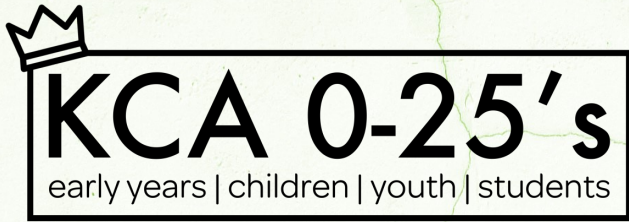

Theme : Faith Session Number: 3

Passage Context

What is true is that it took incredible faith to build an ark so far from any water. What great faith Noah had!



Key Teaching Points

1. Faith is being certain of a God we can't see.
2. Faith is trusting God with your life.

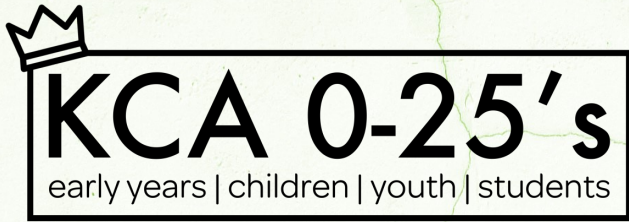

Theme : Ambition Session Number: 4
Biblical Passages: Genesis 11 Topic: The Tower of Babel

Passage Context

In this story people tried to build a temple to reach God, totally missing the point! They became prideful about this structure and their ambition to build this meant they were no longer following God. So God confused their language so they couldn't communicate and gave up. This story is likely a wisdom story told by the ancient Jewish community.

Key Teaching Points

1. We have to recognise some of our ambitions are not good.
2. God has great ambitions for us all.

Give the youth a chance to pray for others, That this world will seek his good plans and help those in need.

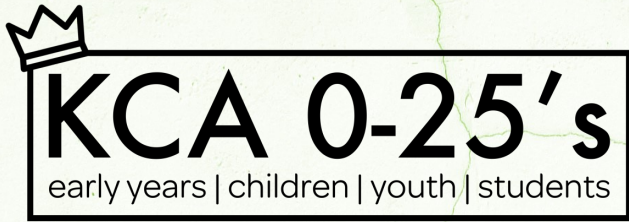

Theme : Obedience Session Number: 5
Biblical Passages: Genesis 22 Topic: Abraham Tested

Passage Context

Make sure to explain Abraham was called by God to be the beginning of this great nation Israel. But he had no family or children! God blessed him and at 100 he had his son Isaac. God promised He would build a great nation through Abraham's son Isaac until one day God tests Abraham's obedience!

Key Teaching Points

1. Obedience is a way we show our love and devotion to God.
2. When we are obedient it hugely please God.

Give the youth a chance to reflect on when they've been disobedient and how they can ask God to help them be obedient!

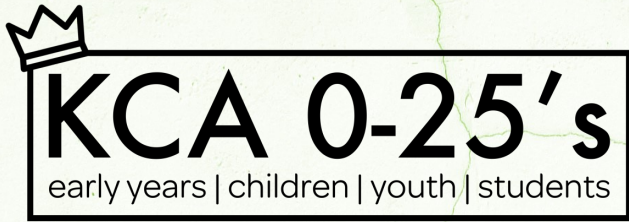

Theme : Sovereign God Session Number: 6
Biblical Passages: Genesis 37-50 Topic: Joseph

Passage Context
 Start by explaining that Joseph was Isaac's grandson. Today's session is to be a brief overview of the story of Joseph, you'll need to pick out the key parts of the story that demonstrate the Sovereignty of God and really explore the meaning of God's Sovereignty. Can God force people to do what He wants if He's truly sovereign etc?

- Key Teaching Points
1. God is sovereign over all things.
 2. Even when things are going bad, God has a plan for you.

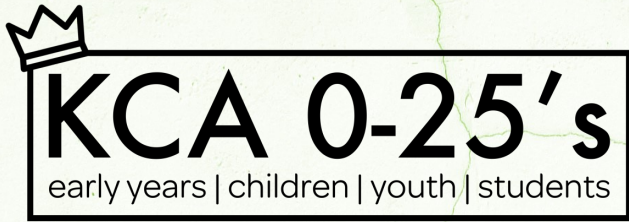

Theme : Powerful God Session Number: 7
Biblical Passages: Exodus 1-11 Topic: Moses

Passage Context
 Explain that after a long time people forgot what Joseph had done and the Israelites became disliked by the Egyptians. The Israelites ended up as slaves to the Egyptians and they didn't seem to have any chance of escape, but with a powerful God there is always hope! This links to last weeks sovereign God, but focusses on how powerful He is. Try to tell the key points of this story again pointing to the power God reveals he has.

- Key Teaching Points
1. God is more powerful than any person, situation or circumstance!
 2. Circumstances can change when we allow to God get involved!

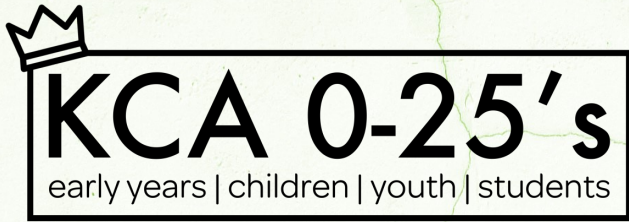

Theme : Rescue Session Number: 8
Biblical Passages: Exodus 12-14 Topic: Passover & Red Sea

Passage Context
 The Israelites were slaves to Egypt, so God put plagues on the land to try to get the Egyptians let the Israelites go. The final plague was the Passover and it was the last straw, so the Pharoah let them go. After a while the Pharoah changed his mind and chased the Israelites. The Israelites were trapped between the Egyptian army and the sea. God rescued them by parting the Red sea and this was their first step toward the promised land.

- Key Teaching Points
1. We can choose for God to rescue us from our sin.
 2. God has the power to rescue us.



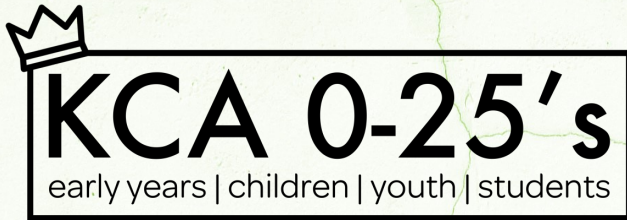

Passage Context

Key Teaching Points

1. God gives us guidance through the His WORD & SPIRIT.
2. To live our best life, this is the key!

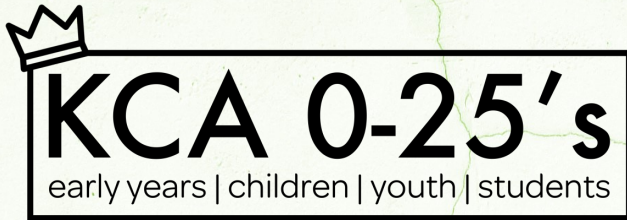

Theme : Trust Session Number: 10
Biblical Passages: Joshua 1-4 Topic: The Promised Land

Passage Context

Explain that after the ten commandments the people stopped trusting God so they wandered the desert for 40 years. After this God said He would lead them to the promised land. Moses died and Joshua had to take the lead just as they were moving into the unknown! We have the crazy story of Rahab and the spies, and then the crossing of the Jordan into the promised Land, where God parts the water again! A new leader, he must've needed big trust in God!

Key Teaching Points

1. We can trust God even when it seems impossible.
2. We don't need all the answers!
