Biblical Passages:	Genesis 1	<u>Topic:</u>	Creation	

Passage Context

The opening chapter of Genesis talks about the creation of the world, that God is above all of creation and that humanity is made in God's likeness. This opening chapter wasn't written as a scientific explanation of how God made the world but that He is it's creator. Genesis chapter 2 holds a second creation story if you want to explore the story slightly differently.


Key Teaching Points


- 1. God created the world.

Passage Context

The people of earth had become evil so God planned to start again with Noah and his family. This flood could have been worldwide, or 'the known' world to the writer or even a story, there is still much debate within the scholars. What is true is that it took incredible faith to build an ark so far from any water. What great faith Noah had!

Biblical Passages:	Genesis 11	Topic:	The Tower of Babel

Passage Context

In this story people tried to build a temple to reach God, totally missing the point! They became prideful about this structure and their ambition to build this meant they were no longer following God. So God confused their language so they couldn't communicate and gave up. This story is likely a wisdom story told by the ancient Jewish community.

Key Teaching Points

- 1. Just because we want something it doesn't make it good.
- 2. God has great ambitions for us all.

Passage Context

Make sure to explain Abraham was called by God to be the beginning of this great nation Israel. But he had no family or children! God blessed him and at 100 he had his son Isaac. God promised He would build a great nation through Abraham's son Isaac, until one day God tests Abraham's obedience!

Key Teaching Points


- 1. When we are obedient it really pleases God.

Biblical Passages:	Exodus 12-14	Topic:	Passover & Red Sea

Passage Context

The Israelites were slaves to Egypt, God had put the plagues on the land and the final one was the Passover, this was the last straw and the Egyptians let them go. After a while the Egyptians changed their minds and chased the Israelites. They were trapped between and Egyptian army and the sea. God rescued them by parting the red sea and this was their first step toward the promised land.

Key Teaching Points

- 1. God has the power to rescue us.
- 2. He will rescue us if we ask him.

Passage Context

After the people had wandered the desert God led them to Mt. Sinai. Here Moses went up the mountain to receive the ten commandments from God. These were given to help them live good lives and for everyone to be in harmony.

- 1. God gives us guidance through the Bible.
- 2. The Bible helps us live our best life!

Biblical Passages:	Joshua 1-4	Topic:	The Promised Land

Passage Context

Explain that after the Ten commandments the people stopped trusting God so they wandered the desert for 40 years. After this God said He would lead them to the promised land. Moses died and Joshua had to take the lead just as they were moving into the unknown! We have the crazy story of Rahab and the spies, and then the crossing of the Jordan into the promised Land, where God parts the water again! A new leader, he must've needed big trust in God!

Key Teaching Points

- 1. We can always trust God.
- 2. God helps us overcome difficult things.
