



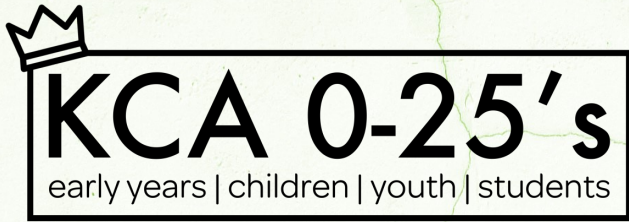

Theme : Mission Session Number: 1
Biblical Passages: Judges 13-16 Topic: Samson

Passage Context

The intention of this session is to teach the broad story of Samson. He was an Israelite and while he had his flaws ultimately his mission was to set the Israelites free from the Philistines. Samson was a judge for Israel which meant he was effectively the leader of the Israelites. Feel free to go into any parts of the story in detail but finish with the fact he completed the mission by destroying the temple which meant the Israelites were set free and that was the mission God had set out for Samson.

Key Teaching Points

1. God has a mission for all of us.
2. God can do amazing things through us!

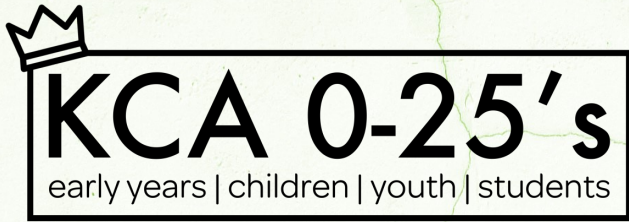

 2. God's will is the best thing for your life.

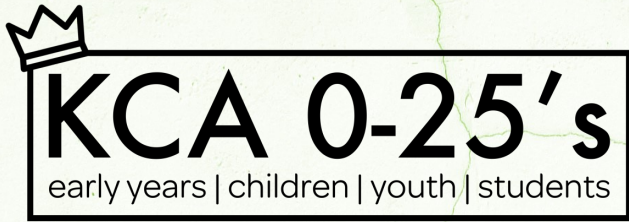

Theme : Truth Session Number: 3
Biblical Passages: 1 Kings 18:16-46 Topic: Elijah & Prophets

Passage Context

Elijah has just been appointed a prophet by King Ahab, after he had prophesied about the end of drought. To show the Alijah served the one TURE God, he set out a challenge to all the prophets of the other gods (Baal and Asherah). Infront of all these people make this fire come alight. The other prophets failed so Elijah put water on the fire, prayed to God and he lit the fire. There was no doubt that his God was the one TRUE God. And all the other gods were fake!

Key Teaching Points

1. God is the one true God.
2. This story shows how Jesus is the real God and the others are fake.

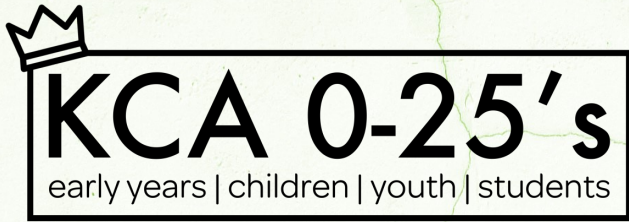

Theme : Purity Session Number: 4
Biblical Passages: 2 Kings 22 & 23 Topic: Josiah

Passage Context

Josiah came at a time when there were many bad king before himself, The tribe of Judah and Israel were split and Josiah was the King of Judah at the age of 8. Bring this story to life for the children so they can understand even at 8 years old they can make decisions about God and live their lives for him. Josiah sought for the nation to be pure so they got rid of the bad things, e.g. the temples and altars, and implemented good things, like praying and worship God.

Key Teaching Points

1. When we do bad things it make us un-pure.
2. We should try to be pure as possible!

Pray that we will live pure lives that please God. Get them to drink the water!

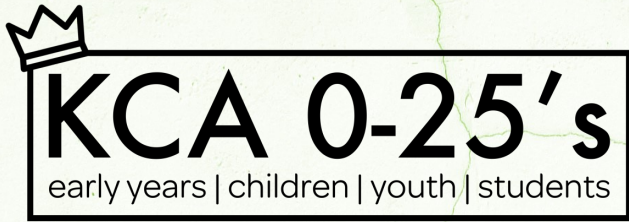

Biblical Passages: **Daniel 3** Topic: **Fiery Furnace**

Passage Context

CRUCIAL TO THIS SESSION IS EXPLAINING > In previous weeks Israel had been free but now their whole country had become captured (by the Babylonians) They were now slaves and because of this they had to accept new laws and rules. The trio that were selected for the fiery furnace were Israelites that loved God and wouldn't bow down to false gods.

Key Teaching Points

1. Courage is standing firm even when you feel weak.
2. God gives us courage to do the right thing.

Pray the children will be brave for God. That even at a young age they might tell others about Jesus!

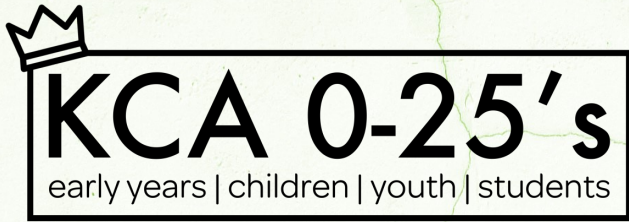

Session Number: 6

Biblical Passages: Daniel 6

Topic: Lions Den

Passage Context

CRUCIAL TO THIS SESSION EXPLAINING > The kids should remember last week the Israelites were now slaves (in Babylon) .

Daniel was a great honest Israelite that was amazing at his job and totally honest. He also was devoted to God and wouldn't bow to any other Gods. Others were Jealous of him and wanted to get rid of him. He could have taken the easy option, but totally refused.

Key Teaching Points

1. Integrity is living our lives true to Jesus... every minute of every day.
2. Integrity means always living the same, at home, at school, with friends.

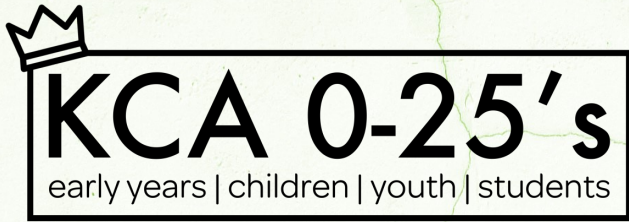

She didn't use her position of power to look out for herself but to protect and free her fellow Israelites that were being treated so badly. God also protected her in her rise to becoming queen, she would be able to say things to the King no one else would dare say.

- Key Teaching Points
1. God protects those that He loves.
 2. We have to accept his protection!

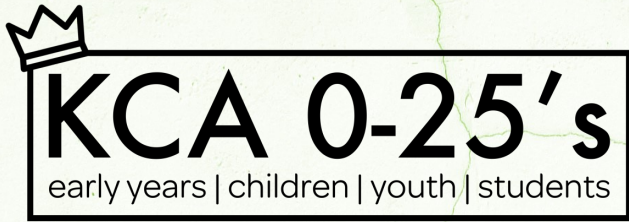

Theme : Restored Session Number: 8
Biblical Passages: Ezra 1-6 Topic: Temple Rebuilt

Passage Context
 CRUCIAL TO THIS SESSION.. EXPLAINING > King Cyrus decreed the Israelites could go back to Jerusalem and build their temple. For the Jewish people this was the promise God had made to them if they would turn from their sin and worship him alone. The temple was restored and so was the relationship with God's people.



- Key Teaching Points
1. We can choose to follow God with our lives.
 2. When we do He restores us to our best!

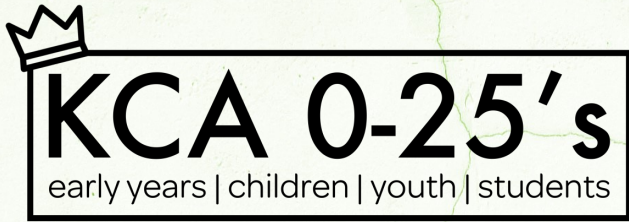

Theme : Grief Session Number: 9

Biblical Passages: Job 1, 2 & 42 Topic: Job

Passage Context

Job is a piece of wisdom literature. It is unlikely that this story is real but it is possible and the Jewish people would have told the story of Job to teach people about being faithful to God even when there is trouble, grief and a world trying to snatch you away.

Using this passage try to help the children to understand that sometimes in life we feel pain. This can be varying levels, but grief is when we feel that pain. This story of Job shows a man who had much grief but he trusted God even though it felt terrible. IN the end he sees that God is faithful and he is restored.

Key Teaching Points

1. Greif is the pain we feel when we are hurt, or have lost someone.
2. We can come to God with our grief/pain and He helps us.

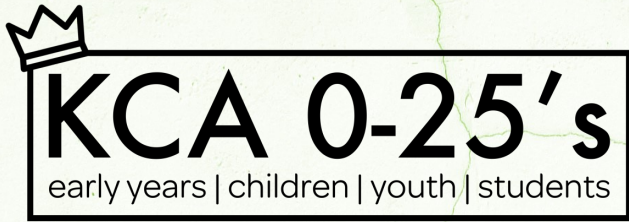

Passage Context

This is an opportunity to talk about how amazing our world is and how it speaks of the person who made it. Not only this but the whole emphasis of the Psalm is about thanking God for how amazing He is and this is something we should replicate in our lives.

Key Teaching Points

2. We should praise God for who He is.
