<u>Theme</u>: Temptation & Self-Control <u>Session Number</u>: 1

<u>Biblical Passages:</u> Matthew 4:1-11 <u>Topic:</u> Jesus Tempted by the Devil

#### Passage Context

Jesus was baptised by John the Baptist and was then led into the wilderness by the Spirit. He endured temptation from the devil, but spoke out the truth of scripture rather than bow to the requests of Satan. Jesus shows us that when we are tempted we can turn to the word of God, and with the Holy Spirit's help we can resist temptation.

### **Key Teaching Points**


- 1. God won't allow us to be tempted beyond what we can bear.
- Jesus endured temptation just like all people do!

Theme: Kindness Session Number: 2

Biblical Passages: John 4:5-26 & 39-42 Topic: Woman at the Well

#### Passage Context

It was well known that Samaritans and Jews did not like each other. It would've been frowned upon for a Jew to interact with a Samaritan let alone sit with them. There was much hostility between them, which makes what Jesus did in this story so outrageous. Jesus not only approached a Samaritan, but a woman who was not even considered a 'good' woman, a loner even in her accepted community! Jesus breaks with cultural norms to reach a broken woman with love and kindness.

### **Key Teaching Points**

- 1. Jesus showed kindness to all.
- 2. Kindness shows people the 'practical' love of God.


Give the young people a chance to pray that God would give them opportunities to be radically kind to others.

Session Number: Theme: Friendship & Fellowship

Biblical Passages: Mark 3:13-19

Topic:

Calling the Disciples

Passage Context—Other Bible passages will help construct this teaching session.

Jesus calls twelve disciples to follow him in this chapter, (four of whom had already been personally called by Jesus to leave their families and jobs). These disciples have already seen many miracles and healings performed by Jesus and would've heard many of His teachings.

Make sure to explain the difference between friendship and fellowship and the importance of developing friendship into fellowship.

### **Key Teaching Points**

- Fellowship is friendship that puts Jesus at the centre
- Fellowship helps us learn, grow and support one another in our faith.

Theme: Prayer Session Number: 4

<u>Biblical Passages:</u> Matthew 6:5-15 <u>Topic:</u> The Lord's Prayer

#### Passage Context

This Lord's prayer is placed amongst the teaching from the sermon on the mount. This is significant because Jesus addresses three key spiritual practices (giving, praying, fasting) and although He teaches about how to pray, each instruction shows that God's focus is on the heart of the person praying and not the outward appearance.

As Jesus prays the Lord's Prayer He gives us an insight into both the heart and function of praying to our Father

### **Key Teaching Points**

- 1. God wants us to pray so we build a relationship with Him.
- 2. The Lord's Prayer helps us see we come before a loving Father.

Theme: Children Session Number: 5

<u>Biblical Passages:</u> Luke 18:15-17 <u>Topic:</u> Jesus Calls the Children

### Passage Context

Jesus uses this interaction with the infants to demonstrate the way in which we should approach God. They come with a huge capacity to love and trust Jesus and aren't trying to make themselves more worthy or act a certain way to impress others or God. This is particularly surprising because children at this time were often perceived as 'there to be seen and not heard' and of a lower value in society.

## **Key Teaching Points**

- 1. We must have a childlike attitude to God.
- 2. Children have great value in God's church.



Theme: Money Session Number: 6

Biblical Passages: Mark 10:17-31 Topic: The Rich Fool

#### Passage Context

Jesus is travelling to Judea when He comes across this rich man. This passage focuses on how those with worldly status and wealth are more prone to rejecting God's ways, with a greater desire for the things they own or control.

Jesus says all this about the difficulty of the rich entering heaven because those with worldly wealth are more open to sins of the heart, like greed, and a focus on acquiring wealth results in God being taken down from the altar of our lives.

### **Key Teaching Points**

- 1. We shouldn't store up earthly treasures.
- 2. Salvation is the greatest gift we can receive.



Theme: Serving Session Number: 7

<u>Biblical Passages:</u> John 13:1-17 <u>Topic:</u> Jesus Washes Disciple's Feet

#### Passage Context

This passage comes at the start of Jesus' last supper with the disciples. Jesus demonstrates what it means to truly serve others. In those days feet would've been a great degree dirtier than now...people wore sandals on streets full of mud, manure and worse. To wash the feet would've been one of the lowliest jobs for only servants, so this demonstration from Jesus would've been beyond shocking to the disciples; that the Son of God would lower himself to such a task.

### **Key Teaching Points**

- 1. We are called to humble ourselves to serve those around us.
- 2. We must serve sacrificially.


Give the young people a chance to pray for others and to ask God to give them specific people He wants them to step out and serve.

Theme: Regret Session Number: 8

#### Passage Context

Luke 22 is about Judas' betrayal, Jesus' Last Supper with his disciples (where they share their first communion) and the arrest and trial of Jesus. Woven through this passage is the story of Peter's betrayal. He begins by vehemently denying that he would ever turn against Jesus, however we see him do exactly that, publicly denying knowing Jesus three times. He exits weeping, in shame and crushing regret he realises what he's done.

### **Key Teaching Points**

- We all have things we regret, you're not alone!
- 2. God can wipe away any guilt from regrets when we turn to Him.

# Practical Prayer RELATIONSHIP


Give the young people a chance to reflect on regrets they have. Turn to God and ask for forgiveness, He can lift the weight of shame.

<u>Theme</u>: Doubt <u>Session Number</u>: 9

Biblical Passages: John 20:24-31 <u>Topic:</u> Doubting Thomas

#### Passage Context

This passage comes after Jesus' death and resurrection. Jesus has not only appeared to many, (e.g. the disciples and Mary Magdalene) but had real post-resurrection encounters with them. Jesus had also visited the disciples when Thomas was not present, therefore, Thomas wasn't able to believe what he was told, (that Jesus was alive); and instead he found himself doubting the truth of this claim.

### **Key Teaching Points**

- 1. We all experience doubts but it doesn't define what's true.
- 2. Even when we doubt we can live in the truth.



Theme: Faithfulness Session Number: 10

Biblical Passages: John 21:15-25 <u>Topic:</u> Peter Re-instated

#### Passage Context

This passage comes after Jesus' death and resurrection and is one of the last interactions Jesus has with the disciples before ascending to heaven.

When Jesus was arrested and led away, Peter denied knowing Him three times, (just as Jesus had foretold at the last supper). Here we see Jesus reinstating Peter by asking if he loves Him three times and then appointing him to 'feed' His sheep. This is dramatic as Jesus asks him to be a leader of the 'flock' even after blatantly failing.

### **Key Teaching Points**

- 1. Even when we turn from God, He remains faithful.
- 2. When we fail, God not only picks us up but still sees our potential!
